## 4. RANGE OF OCCUPATIONS ACCESSIBLE TO THE HOLDER OF THE CERTIFICATE



Graduates are employed in the field of woodworking production, particularly in the production and repair of upholstery products and in decorator work. After acquiring the necessary practical experience in the field, they are soon prepared to run their own businesses in the given area.

Examples of possible job positions include: upholsterer and decorator, manufacturer and repairman of upholstered furniture, door upholsterer, vehicle upholsterer, button maker etc.
